2. Hazards & Warnings

Symbol	Hazard	Precaution Measures
	 The product contains rotating blades and sharp knives. Misuse may cause deep cutting to the skin and bleeding. 	 Never insert hands or utensils while the product is operating. Always ensure the lid is closed after putting the food waste.
	 The product contains cables and wires connecting with sensors and electronic components. Misuse may cause electric shock, short circuit or fire. 	 Do not connect or disconnect the adaptor to an outlet with a wet hand. Do not clean with water when the adaptor is attached. Ensure the unit Is plugged into a properly grounded outlet. Do not use in a way exceeding the rating of the household outlet or the wiring. Always ensure the appliance is operated on an electric power source matched to the rated voltage indicated on the adaptor.
	 The product has a rechargeable lithium battery. Misuse may cause fluid leak, overheating or explosion. 	 Do not charge the battery after it has been removed from the product. Do not throw the battery into fire or apply heat. If the battery fluid leaks out, do not touch the battery with your bare hands.
	 Composts have risks of bacterial growth, mould and foul odours. Skin irritation may happen for sensitive skin when comes in contact with the compost. 	 Wear gloves and use a shovel when collecting the compost from the storage box. Avoid composting meat, dairy or oily foods. (Refer in table below) Regularly monitor the composition of the compost.
	The product has risks of cracking, deformation or collapse due to excessive weight.	 Do not stack heavy items on top of the product. Place the product on a level surface to prevent tipping.

3. Tips for Composting


To get the high-quality compost from your Loopbin, focus on these key factors:

- 1. Air Circulation
- Ensure good airflow.
- Turn the compost regularly to prevent odour and support microorganisms.
- 2. Material Balance
- 1:1 mix of greens (wet, nitrogen-rich) and browns (dry, carbon-rich).
- Avoid overloading with one type of waste.
- 3. Particle Size
- Chop food waste into small pieces (ideally 0.5 5 cm).
- Smaller pieces decompose faster due to larger surface area.
- 4. Temperature
- Compost efficiently at 50 °C to 60 °C.
- Avoid extreme temperatures which slow microbial activity.
- 5. Moisture Content
- Keep moisture at 55 % to 65 %.
- Too dry? Add greens. Too wet? Add browns like shredded paper.
- 6. Oxygen Levels
- Composting must stay aerobic.
- Maintain oxygen levels between 7 % and 12 %. Never below 5 %.

For a pleasant composting experience, refer to the *Compostable & Non-Compostable Materials Table* below to reduce odours and ensure top-quality output.

5. Operating Instructions

1. Connect the bin with the cable and adapter provided. Download the app "Loopbin" at the App Store or Google Play.



2. Open the lid on the top of the bin. Put the food waste (daily max. 0.3 kg) into the bin.




3. Rotate the mixer by using the handle at the first chamber.




4. Constantly monitor the condition of the compost using the app. The app gives you a notification when the hatch is ready to open, approximately after 4 weeks.







5. Transfer the compost to 2nd chamber by using the opener provided. Mix the compost again from time to time.



6. When the compost is ready to be collected, make sure to open the hatch before the storage box. If you wish, use the storage box for plants and place it on top of the bin.



Note:

- Energy consumption: 0.23 kWh/month
- Each layer of the bin has a capacity up to 10 L

6. Warranty

What Loopbin warranty covers?

This warranty covers damage / defects in:

- Electrical Components: Sensors, microcontroller, ventilator fan, power adapter.
- Mechanical Components: Mixer, handle, blades, lid mechanism, structural integrity
- Materials & Workmanship: Damage caused by manufacturing defects or material failure under normal home use.
- During delivery process

What Loopbin warranty does not cover?

- Normal wear and tear (e.g., blade dullness, discoloration).
- Damage caused by misuse, neglect, or improper handling.
- Attempted repair or modification by unauthorized parties.
- Composting of non-organic materials that causes damage to the bin, or noncompostable materials that attract pests and animals.
- App performance when not using the latest update

If your Loopbin develops a fault during the warranty period:

- Provide a description of the issue (photos or video recommended).
- Please note that any damage incurred during the delivery process must be reported within **7 days** of receiving the product.
